Edward Hurn McCollum, 87, passed away on Thursday, February 25, 2010 at Mitchell Hollingsworth. He graduated from Stetson University, and Southern Theological Seminary, Louisville, KY. He pastored churches in Kentucky, Indiana, Tennessee, Florida, and Alabama. He retired from Ford Motor Company after 19-1/2 years where he was known as "Preacher". The visitation will be 6:00 - 8:00 p.m. Saturday, February 27, 2010 at Spry Memorial Chapel. The funeral service will be at 2:00 p.m. Sunday, February 28, 2010 at Spry Memorial Chapel.
