September 29, 1930 - January 31, 2008

Joseph (Joe) William Turbyfill, age 77, Orange Beach, AL passed away on Thursday, January 31, 2008 in Pensacola, FL. The visitation and funeral services will be at 1:00 p.m. and 2:00 p.m. respectively on Saturday, February 2, 2008 at Spry Memorial Chapel. Interment will follow in Franklin Memory Gardens. A memorial service may be held in Orange Beach at a later date. He was preceded in death by his parents, John and Sula Turbyfill, Russellville.
