Timothy "Tim" Dale Reed, 65, of Phil Campbell, AL passed away on Friday February 15, 2019.

Tim earned a Masters in Biology from Auburn University and a PhD in Entomology from Clemson University. He worked as an Extension Entomologist for Cotton and Soybeans at Auburn University Department of Entomology and Plant Pathology. Prior to that he worked as a county agent for the Extension service in the Covington and Franklin Counties where he helped numerous farmers.

Visitation will be held at Mountain View Baptist Church in Phil Campbell on Sunday, February 17, 2019 from 5:00-8:00 pm. The body will lie in state from 9:30 - 11:00 a.m. Monday, February 18, 2019 at Mountain View Baptist Church with the funeral following at 11:00 a.m. with Bro. Sammy Taylor officiating. Burial will be in the adjoining church cemetery

Tim was preceded in death by his parents, Billy and Regenia Reed of Caddo, AL.
